COVID 19 ARENA USE PROCEDURES
(Updated October 1, 2021)

General Information

- All participants must abide by federal, provincial, municipal, and organizational COVID-19 safety plans/orders.
- Maintain social distance of two metres. Stay home if sick or feeling unwell. Wear masks. Wash hands.
- Have fun! 😊

Entrance Rules

- In accordance with the Interior Health Order for Gatherings and Events and in support of requests from arena sport groups, effective October 1, 2021, the City of West Kelowna, will provide increased access into City arenas, to a maximum of 50 percent capacity into Jim Lind Arena (150 people) and Royal LePage Place (750 people) for fully vaccinated residents (2 doses).
- Proof of full vaccination (2 doses) is required to enter the facility for all those who are 22 years or older and all **spectators** who are 12 years or older.
- **Participants** under the age of 22 do not require proof of vaccination.
- Operational essential personnel are allowed access into the facility. This may include: coaches, referees, timekeeper, scorekeeper, music technicians, team manager, trainer, COVID Ambassador.
- Adults/parents who are required to support young children in programs, do not require proof of vaccination.
- Effective October 1, 2021, facility access for participants will be increased to **30 minutes** prior to rental.
- A COVID Ambassador must assist every group with accessing facilities and managing occupancy limits.
- Wait outside the building until your COVID Ambassador has arrived.
- Arena staff will only open doors for the COVID Ambassador.
- Arena staff will open doors 30 minutes prior to the ice rental.
- Doors must remain locked at all times.
- Everyone must wear masks when inside City facilities.
- Users must use designated entrance and exit locations.

Change Area Rules

- Arena dressing rooms are open and assigned to each rental.
- Wear masks at all times when inside dressing rooms.

On Ice Rules

- Social distancing is not required on the field of play.
- When outside the field of play all participants must remain a minimum of two metres apart.
- No sharing of water bottles.
- At the end of the session, participants must exit the ice on time so that the next group can start as scheduled.

Miscellaneous Rules

- No spitting anywhere on or off the ice.
- **Sanitization of the arena spaces will occur periodically. Wash your hands.**
